

Lincolnshire Challenge Shield - Hemswell Cliff Thursday 18th June

Two Sprint Races back-2-back with a "Super" Prologue followed by a Sprint Chase –

NO ENTRY ON THE NIGHT - NO EXCEPTIONS!

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES (to Team Captains) - FRIDAY 12th JUNE

Parking / Assembly / Start / Finish all adjacent. Fees £3 Seniors, £2 Juniors

We are using Psi Loops* as a means to gaffle the courses, it is very important that you are pre-entered as your maps are individual to you (random draw made prior to event competition).

Super Prologue start times will be pre-allocated in order that head to head HALO v LOG contests can take place for this first course. If you miss your start it may be that your time may count from when you should have started, not from when you actually started, so please be punctual!

Start Times will be 6pm - 7pm, please advise your Team Captain in which start block you wish to be allocated -

Early (6pm-6:20pm), Middle (6:20pm-6:40pm) or late (6:40pm-7pm)

Should you mis-punch or DSQ in the "Super" Prologue you will still be allocated a Start Time for the Chase

Chase Start Times : 7:30pm PLUS your Super Prologue Time

Example : if you run 12 minutes 40 seconds in the Super Prologue your Chasing Start Time will be 7:42 and 40 seconds.

Hemswell Cliff comprises a mixture of open grassed areas, oddly shaped and isolated individual buildings and a complex housing estate. Fast running throughout, minimal traffic, map scale 1:3,000 A4 Waterproof, separate descriptions available.


*Psi Loops -

"Super" Prologue and Chase - there will be two Psi Loops in each race, you MUST complete them in the correct order! You will run any one of FOUR combinations so BE CAREFUL!


In the Chase there may also be a Butterfly Loop to complete.

Loops will always run in a ClockWise direction
