<b>Location &amp; Parking</b>	<p>To avoid the Town Centre please approach from the South using the A16 Western Ring Road. At the Southern junction with the B1520 (TF324850) , follow Coach Park sign left at the Roundabout. After 2kms , 100m after the Cemetery turn Right into the Livestock Market London Road Entrance (also Coach Park sign). (<a href="#">link</a>).</p> <p><b>Please Note: There are speed cameras on the Ring Road</b></p> <p><b>Plenty of Hard Standing Parking with no height restrictions. Camper Vans ok but not for overnight stays please.</b></p>			
<b>Terrain</b>	Excellent Urban Mix of Alleyways and Cut Throughs within the town, with longer courses visiting interesting adjacent residential and suburban areas			
<b>Map</b>	1:5000, 5m contours. Extended and updated 2018. Maps will be printed on waterproof paper.			
<b>Entries</b>	<p>SIAC Electronic punching will be used at this event. Standard SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire (£1) or pre entries can also hire SIAC (£2). Lost hired SI cards will be charged at £30/£60 respectively.</p> <p>Online entries (advised) through Fabian4 (<a href="http://www.fabian4.co.uk">www.fabian4.co.uk</a>).
