The event will be signposted from the A1034 South Cave to Market Weighton road at Sancton. Turn west off the A1034 in Sancton at Grid Ref SE 901372 and follow the road for approx. 900m. Parking / Assembly will be approx. 300m along the track south from SE 893388.

NEW LOCATION!

Houghton Wood is a flat mixed area. There are large areas of newly planted trees, **Terrain** patches of impenetrable rhododendrons, and some runnable woodland. There are plenty of paths and tracks. The area is used extensively for shooting in the season.

1:10000 (all courses), 5m contours. Survey 2008, updated 2014. Maps are A4 size Map

and will be printed on waterproof paper.
