Directions: Signed from the A18 200m E of Humberside Airport and from A46 1 mile E of Caistor.

Entrance is at grid Ref: TA 127032

Car Parking: Is adjacent to Registration on a wide ride to either side of a track. Please park as directed by marshals. There are log piles on the ride. Please do not climb on these.

Assembly: Enquiries, EOD Registration, Download, Results and First Aid will be in to your left as you enter the car park. Toilets are adjacent to registration.

String Course: A free string course is available 250m from Registration on the way to the start.

Pre-entries: Control descriptions are printed on the front of the map and loose descriptions will be available at the Start at -3 mins. Dibber Hire is from Enquiries. Those with own dibbers should go straight to the start.

EOD: EOD Entries for all courses are subject to map availability

BOF members with their own SI dibber need not fill out a form but just identify your Entry fee on the EOD form. Go to Registration / Pay Desk, pay then dib to register.

BOF members without own SI dibber, or non BOF members please fill out form & proceed to Registration / Pay Desk. Please identify your Entry fee on the EOD form

Competitors can enter any course, but to be eligible for the YHOA Championships they must enter the correct course for their class. Any competitor, who wishes to change their course, should go to registration before their run (there will be no fee for this).

Mementoes (mugs) are awarded to the first placed YHOA club member in each class.

Map & Terrain: Map 1:10000 with 5 m contours updated winter 2012. Maps are A3 printed on waterproof paper. Control descriptions are printed on the front of the map. Thanks go to the Yarborough Estate Office for permission to use Pillar Woods which is a fast open working forest with a network of

wide rides. There are both numerous rootstocks varying in size from 0.2m high stumps to 1.5m high fallen trees and numerous knolls the majority of which are overgrown former rootstocks. When a rootstock becomes a knoll can therefore be a matter of interpretation.

HAZARDS: There is a certain amount of debris, farm machinery and log piles lying around. The other hazard that you will encounter are the numerous holes created by the burrowing animals these can be large and deep - take care.

Green X indicates Rootstock Black X indicates Shelter Special Symbols used:

Control Descriptions: Control descriptions will be on the front of the map. All courses will use IOF symbols. White and Yellow courses will have written descriptions.

Additional symbol used for control descriptions: Cross within a circle - Rootstock:

Start: If you have pre-entered and already have a dibber, then proceed to the Start. The Start is 500 m from Registration. From Registration follow the ride to the signed route leading East to the start.

There will be a punching start

White & Yellow Course maps can be picked up before the start at -4mins. Assistance can be given at this point. Loose control descriptions on waterproof paper are available at - 3 mins. Blank maps will be displayed at -2mins.

Those who are late for the start should report to the start official. You will be allocated a vacant slot but may have to wait until there is a 4 min separation between you and a fellow club member

Controls: SI boxes are on the top of stakes. There is a blank control flag, the Control Number being horizontally on the SI box itself.

Finish: Please report to download at Registration.

This is a Championship. Please do not show your map to anyone who has not run.

All competitors must Download even if they retire and do not finish the course

Results: Provisional results will be on display at Registration. Final results will be on the HALO website.

Complaints & protests: Any competitor who wishes to make a complaint should go to Enquiries to discuss the matter with the Organiser. If the competitor is unhappy with the decision a protest may be made in writing to the Controller. A fee of £5.00 is payable (refundable if the protest is upheld). If required a jury will be convened.

Safety:

Please take care near registration where cars may be entering or leaving the car park. All competitors are advised to carry a whistle. If the weather is bad, then capoules may be compulsory. A sign will be displayed on the way to the start.

See note under Map and terrain for HAZARDS that might be encountered in the forest.

Any competitor travelling alone is advised to leave their car keys at Enquiries.
