TRAVEL

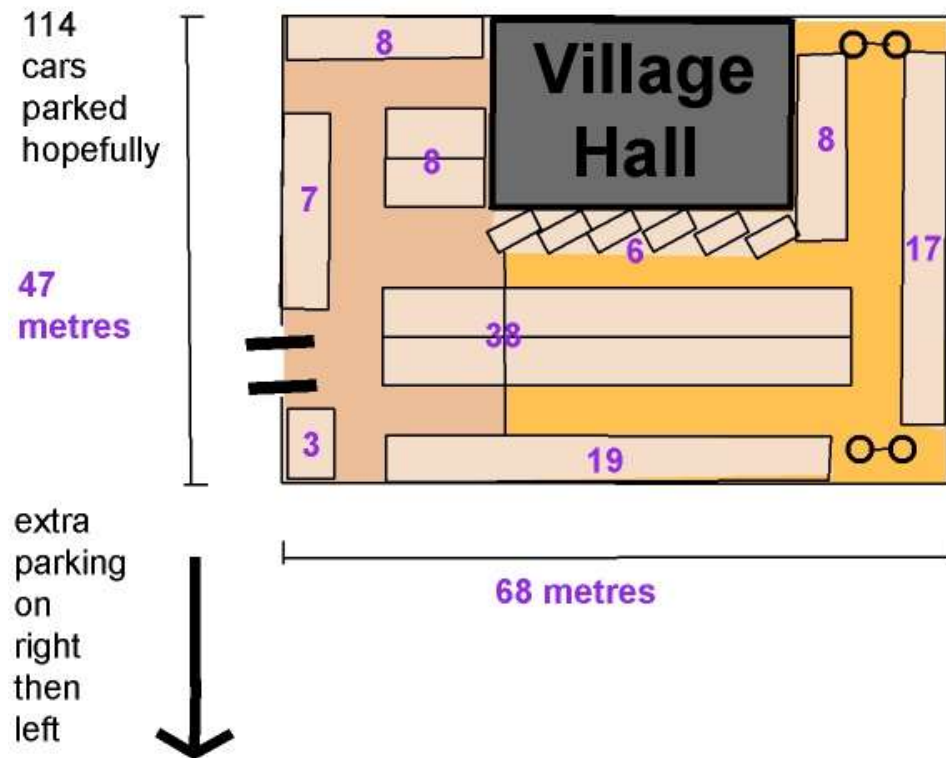
From the M180 eastbound at junction 5, take the 4th exit off the roundabout then to a second round-a-bout then take the first exit onto the A18 following signs to Humberside Airport. Continue along the A18 for a further 4km until Great Limber Village. Turn right at the left-hand bend towards the Village Hall Car Park. **POSTCODE - DN37 8JL**

COACH TRAVEL

Those travelling by coach can be dropped at the Village Hall.
Coach parking is directly across the road in **J.W.Joyce's Yard**.
Those bringing a coach must contact Brian Slater in advance for instructions.

PARKING & REGISTRATION

Please park where directed. We may be using road-side parking on minor roads in the village for later arrivals. Registration is in the Village Hall, with seating areas and toilets.
There is a marshaled road crossing on the way to the start & finish.

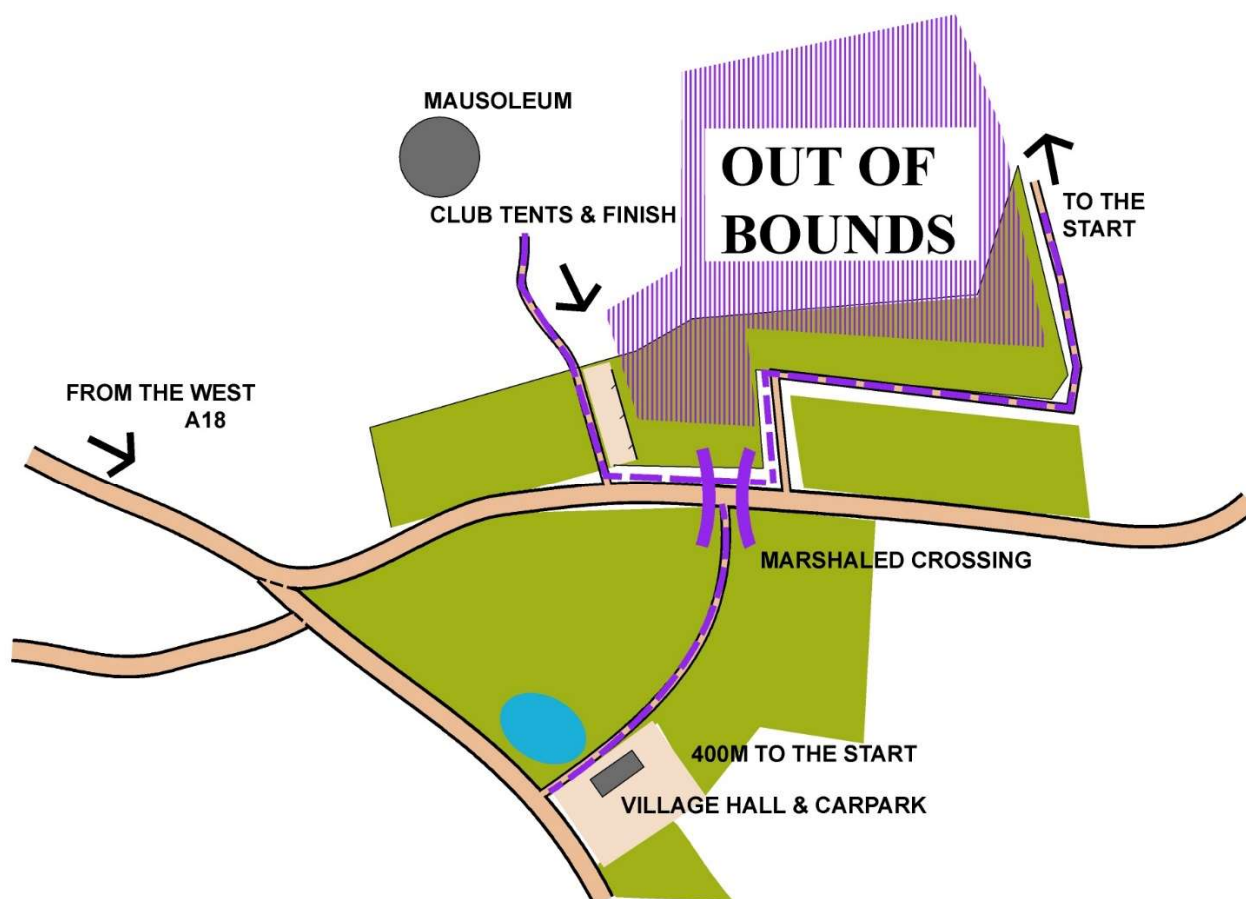

STARTS

10.30 to 12.30

The start & finish are approximately 400m from the Village Hall (follow marked route) (obey marshaled road crossing). **Please see the attached diagram showing routes to and from start, finish & registration.**

DESCRIPTIONS

Collected in -2 start lane.

ROAD CROSSING

The Blue and Brown course will have a timed out crossing of the A18 (1 minute allowed).

The road is very busy and a 60mph speed limit.

The Marshal will have a full view of traffic from both directions.

Please follow their instructions re crossing.

From the East the outward route there is a limited view. On return it is better.

Register your 'dibber' at both sides, both ways.

There is a drinks station on the West side of the road. Dib first then drink.

DOWNLOAD

This will be at the Village Hall registration point.

This is approximately 300m from FINISH.

Those wishing to spectate can return to the Mausoleum area after downloading.

Adults may wish to bring a junior's dibber or several at a time to registration/download.

RESULTS

On the day (display screens at registration) and then on the web later.

COURSES CLOSE

2pm

TERRAIN

This is the most runnable area in our region – not to be missed!

The area consists of mixed woodland with a good ride & path network.

There is a main wide ride through the valley with wide ride off-shoots and many smaller paths.

Some of the wooded areas have rhododendrons which are hard to penetrate.

At this time of year this private woodland owned by The Earl of Yarborough is at its best.

OTHER USERS

Though private woodlands, a dedicated walk is open to the public, from April 1st to August 31st.

Please respect others who may be picnicking, horse riding, site seeing or walking their dogs.

MAP

Yellow to Green 1:7500 scale. 5m contours;

Blue to Black 1:10000 scale. 5m contours.

Maps will have courses pre-marked on A4 waterproof paper (recyclable as paper), printed by HALO.

SAFETY

Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.

NEWCOMERS

All welcome at HALO events. Bring a compass and ask at registration for assistance.
