There is a reason why it will be marked as *uncrossable*, possibly at a landowner's request, and if competitors are seen breaking these rules our future use of the area may be in jeopardy. A couple of people have come forward and "confessed" that when reviewing the map at home they can see that they have crossed where they shouldn't and agreed to be disqualified - we thank them for their honesty.

One person, however, was spotted crossing a 6ft boundary near control 65 which I would suggest was neither safe nor easy. We do not know who this person was so cannot disqualify them for a clear breach of the rules and possibly a significant time advantage. We do however know that they were wearing an **Ebor top and shorts** - was it you?
