





Location &	Grid Reference TA129037 (Pelham's Pillar), 3km NE of Caistor, Lincolnshire.					
Parking	At 'Caistor Top' on the A46, follow the A1173 for 1km approx., bear left – look for signs to turn right into the wood via the game-keeper's cottage, ( <b>Postcode : LN76RP).</b> <b>CONTINUE TOWARDS Pelham's Pillar – park neatly please.</b>					
Terrain	An area of mixed woodland with long valleys, some steep slopes, a large open area towards the centre and very wide rides throughout the woods. There is a variety of contour detail and good runnability.
