

Humber Bridge TrailO Weekend 20-21 September 2025

Saturday 20 September: Humber Bridge Country Park, Hessle

Start Times: 3.00 pm - 5.00 pm

Sunday 21 September: Baysgarth Park, Barton-Upon-Humber

Start Times: 11.00 am - 1.00 pm

Courses (*provisional*): There will be one Pre-O course at each area of circa 80 minutes plus a timed A-Z section. Both days, on the way to the starts, there will be sample kites to practice techniques, and to coach beginners. New maps are being prepared of each area, probably 1:3000.

Terrain: Saturday - an old chalk quarry surrounded by high cliffs with complex vegetation; Sunday - parkland with distinctive trees and many manmade features. Both areas and courses are wheelchair accessible.

Access: Both sites are close to train stations and bus routes. Parking is also available at each site.

Facilities: Toilets are available at each site.

Accommodation: Staying Saturday night locally? There is a Premier Inn adjacent to the Humber Bridge Country Park (see: <u>Link</u>) with many other options in Kingston upon Hull.

Entries: Entries will be by racesignup - opens in June. Fees: tbc
